WHEREAS, Articles of Incorporation of



Articles of Incorporation of a Nonprofit Corporation

(Submit with a filing fee of \$25.00)

Article I Name

The name of the corporation is **St. Andrew Presbyterian Church @ Hideaway, Inc.**

Article II Type

The Corporation is a **public** nonprofit religious corporation.

Article III Duration

The period of duration of the Corporation is **perpetual**.

Article VI Members

This Corporation will have members. Only members on the active role of the St. Andrew Presbyterian Church @ Hideaway shall be members of the Corporation.

Article VII Dissolution

If the church is formally dissolved by the Presbytery of which it is a member, or has become extinct by reason of the dispersal of its members, the abandonment of its work, or any other cause, all such property, both real and personal, present and future, as the Corporation may have shall be vested in and be the property of the Presbytery of John Calvin of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), pursuant to the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), said Presbytery being an organization qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States. In the alternative, said property of the Corporation shall be held, used and applied for such uses, purposes and trust as the Presbytery may direct, limit and appoint, or such property may be sold or disposed of as the Presbytery may direct in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

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Creation - Non-Profit

Article VIII Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are more fully set forth in the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), including:

The Great Ends of the church:

- the proclamation of the gospel for the salvation of humankind;
- the shelter, nurture, and spiritual fellowship of the children of God;
- the maintenance of divine worship;
- the preservation of the truth;
- the promotion of social righteousness; and
- the exhibition of the kingdom of heaven to the world.

In furtherance of the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and the purposes stated above, the Corporation shall exercise powers as set out herein.

Article IX Support and Conform to the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)

The Corporation shall support, at all times and in all respects, the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The Corporation and all of its property, both real and personal, shall be subject to the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), as it is now or shall be, from time to time, amended, established, made, and declared by the authority of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The business of the Corporation shall be conducted in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), as it is now or shall be, from time to time, amended, established, made, and declared by the authority of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

Article X All Property Held in Trust for the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)

All property, both real or personal, held by or for the particular church, whether title is lodged in the Corporation, the board of trustees or a trustee, or an unincorporated association, and whether the property is used in programs of the particular church or retained for the production of income, is held in trust nevertheless for the use and benefit of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

Article XI Powers and Duties

The Corporation shall have the powers and duties granted by the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.):

- To receive, hold, encumber, manage, and transfer property, real or personal, for the church;
- To accept and execute deeds of title to such property;
- To hold and defend title to such property;
- To manage any permanent special funds for the furtherance of the purposes of the church.
- In addition, to the extent not included in the above and not inconsistent with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), the Corporation shall have all of the general powers of a nonprofit religious corporation organized under the State of Missouri (Section 355 known as State Nonprofit Act).
- The powers and duties of the trustees shall not infringe upon the powers and duties of the session and the board of deacons of the church and such powers and duties shall be exercised in conformity with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).
- In addition, the Corporation shall not engage in ultra vires acts.

Article XII Restrictions on Corporations Exempt from Federal Taxation

No part of the assets of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article XIII Effective Date

The effective date of this document is the date it is filed by the Secretary of State of Missouri unless a future date is otherwise included: **January 1, 2017.**


